

RIDE TRANSIT COMMUTER CREDITS PROGRAM
PARTICIPATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Program Registration. Registration for the Ride Transit Commuter Credits program (the “Program”) begins June 24, 2019 and will end on September 30, 2019. In order to be eligible to participate in this Program, You must not have taken an Eligible Route three (3) or more times per week on average over the last 3 months. Your participation in this Program is strictly voluntary. If you do not agree to these terms and conditions, please do not go any further and do not complete your registration. You, the participant (“You” or “Your”), can register for the Program anytime within this registration timeframe. Once registered, You will be notified of Your official start date to begin earning toll credits when riding the Eligible Routes on the I-85 and the I-75 Express Lanes instead of driving Your normal commute. The Program will begin on July 1, 2019 and continue on a rolling basis until September 30, 2019.

Registration Criteria. In order to successfully register for this Program, You must:

1. Identify an Xpress, Gwinnett County Transit (GCT), or CobbLink route that operates along the Express Lanes corridor from the list below (the “Eligible Routes”); and
2. Be a valid Peach Pass Toll Personal account holder and have an unexpired Breeze Card; and
3. Not have taken an Eligible Route three (3) or more times per week on average over the last 3 months; and

Eligible Routes. The Eligible Routes are set forth in <https://www.peachpass.com/ridetransit/>

Program Eligibility. It is a condition of Your participation that all information supplied by You will be correct, current and complete. We may contact You to verify the information provided. SRTA has the right to refuse or discontinue Your participation in this Program, including the right to withhold any toll credits if we believe You have failed to meet Your obligations. Each participant can register one Breeze Card per valid Peach Pass transponder per registration. You must use that same Breeze Card You used to register for the Program to pay for all qualifying transit trips. After You complete the online registration form and Your Peach Pass and Breeze Card accounts have been verified by SRTA, You will be notified of the eligible start date from which you can begin to participate in the Program and earn toll credits.

Earning Toll Credits. For the duration of the Program, Your Peach Pass and Breeze card accounts must be in good standing and the Peach Pass account must have no outstanding violations. Qualifying trips must be taken between 6 a.m. and 10 a.m. or 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. Monday-Friday only (the “Peak Hours”). All trips must be taken from July 1, 2019 to September 30, 2019 during Peak Hours in order to be eligible to earn toll credits. Each participant can earn \$5.00 in toll credits per qualified trip. Participants can earn a maximum of \$5.00 per day and a maximum of \$50.00 in toll credits per month when participating in this Program. Toll credits cannot be refunded or redeemed for cash nor transferred from one account to another. If You close Your account before using the toll credits, You forfeit any and all unused toll credits earned during this Program. Earned toll credits, if any, will be applied to Your Peach Pass account on a monthly basis. Credits will be applied to the Peach Pass account by no later than the twentieth of the following month. (i.e., credits in April will be applied by the 20th of May). By choosing to participate, You are aware that specific trip information (such as trip times, locations, fare media, etc.) related to Your Breeze Card transactions will be used for verification purposes in order for SRTA to verify and apply earned toll credits to your account. You also understand that if SRTA’s toll collection system reads your transponder in the Express Lanes corridor during the same Peak Time that the transit trip will be ineligible for toll credits.

Privacy. SRTA respects the privacy of its customers. SRTA does not sell or share its customer list with outside marketers. SRTA may use the contact information provided by You to communicate with You. Such communication may concern Your accounts and marketing communications related to SRTA. You agree that SRTA or its designee may collect anonymous traffic, travel or other statistical information using the Peach Pass or Breeze Card. SRTA will not allow the use of or assist any third party to use this data in a way that associates Your personal identifying information with the anonymous information obtained unless required by law or by court order.

Disputes. Disputes may be emailed to commutercredits@peachpass.com. If a dispute (including but not limited to interpretation of the Program requirements, accuracy of the information provided by You, or Your eligibility to participate in the Program) occurs, SRTA shall be the final decision-maker. Any decision by SRTA will be final.

Termination. The Program may be terminated or any of the Terms and Conditions may be revised by SRTA at any time, for any reason, with or without notice to You. SRTA will post all revisions and notices on its website.

Indemnification/Hold Harmless. You hereby assume full responsibility and all risk which may result from Your participation in this Program and hereby agree to hold harmless, release, waive, forever discharge and covenant not to sue or bring claims against the State Road and Tollway Authority (SRTA), their officers, agents, or employees. The terms of these terms and conditions shall serve as a release and assumption of risks for Your heirs, executors, administrators and for all of Your family members. You acknowledge that You have read this information and agree to its terms by submitting Your application. You further understand and acknowledge that the Program may be changed at any time without notice.
